During the second half of the Summer term in Theme we will be exploring different types of weather in our immediate environment along with the four seasons. In Science we will be looking at different scientists and inventors from the past. The ideas below are just suggestions. Feel free to add any of your own.

At home, watch a TV or online weather forecast for 2 days. Listen to what the forecaster says and look at the weather symbols. Record the type of weather and the temperature for Liverpool. Look around your home to find an invention that you think is amazing! Draw a picture of this invention and write a sentence or two to explain why you think it is amazing.

If you have access to a computer at home, type some sentences about a recent trip, activity or something you did at home. Use paint software to create a picture to illustrate.

Find out about a ritual in Sikhism. Draw and write about what you found out.

Choose your favourite traditional tale and write your own alternative ending.

Draw a picture for each month of the year showing something that happens in that month. For example, an Autumn tree in October.

With help from an adult use the internet to research about traditional tales from around the world.

Have a go at making your own clock at home using a paper plate and some pins, or draw one. Can you show what time you get up, have lunch and go home from school?
