

## Year 3

During the second half of the Autumn term in theme we will be learning about The United Kingdom and the four countries that make it. In Science we will be looking at Light. The ideas below are just suggestions. Feel free to be creative and add some of your own.



In Science we are learning about Light. You could look at the types of lights you use in your house. Do you have candles, night lights or torches? You could draw pictures or take photographs of some of the lights and label them. You could investigate the lights near your house or look at the Christmas lights in town.

Read regularly or have stories read to you. Particularly, Mythical stories. You could ask family members if they know any mythical stories that you could share.

We are looking at Faith stories in RE. Read a story from a major faith and try to learn it. Re -tell the story in your own words. Illustrate it in comic book style. Use a piece of computer software to create a fact file about Light and light sources. Think about natural lights and man made lights.

> Draw or paint Light sources, draw a map of the UK and label places you have visited. You could draw characters from Mythical stories you have read.

Write a book review about the stories you have read. What did you like about the story? Who was your favourite character? Would you have ended the story differently? If so, how? Keep practising number bonds to 10, 20, 50, 100 and beyond. E.g. what goes with 17 to make 20? What goes with 55 to make 100? Learn you 4 and 8 times tables. Can you answer questions randomly from these tables?

Go out at different times of day and make a report on what types of light you see each time. Remember to take an adult out with you if you are not in your own garden or yard.
