During the first half of the Spring term in theme we will be learning about the Romans and their effects on Great Britain. In Science we will be looking at Rocks. The ideas below are just suggestions. Feel free to be creative and add some of your own.



In Science we are learning about Rocks. You could look at rocks in your environment. How do we use rocks to build now and in the past? Research what a palaeontologist does, and how they have helped us learn more about prehistoric animals. Create a fact file on Mary Anning (a famous Palaeontologist).

Read regularly or have stories read to you. Particularly, Mystery stories. You could ask family members if they know any mystery stories that you could share.

We are looking at signs and symbols in RE. Read a story from a major faith and try to learn it. Re-tell the story in your own words. Illustrate it in comic book style. Use a piece of computer software to create a fact file about Rocks or Roman Britain. Can you find out about

You could draw a setting for a mystery story and then write the story.

Write a book review about the stories you have read. What did you like about the story? Who was your favourite character? Would you have ended the story differently? If so, how?

Keep working on your 3,4 and 8 times tables. Can you make up some fractions questions to test someone in your family? Can you explain what Equivalent fractions are to someone at home? Practise measuring objects around the house, bake a cake and measure all of the ingredients.
