

When?	Monday 1st June onwards Time W/c 01 June 8am – 4pm The timings are flexible in terms of drop off and collection between these times.
Where?	Provision will continue to use Early Years indoor/outdoor areas Please continue to drop off and collect your child at the main office, observing social distancing measures.
Who?	Children of Key workers (see definitions) School should be notified in advance Children deemed vulnerable (risk assessed by the school)
Safety measures – Children	Movement around the school is kept to a minimum. Children and staff are placed into small groups (bubbles) Structured activities which can take place outdoors are encouraged, with appropriate social distancing. Children to be supervised washing their hands at key points in the school day Infection control - “Catch it, bin it, kill it” for sneezes etc If any children show symptoms, they will be isolated and will need to be collected. They will only be able to return to school after a negative test.
Safety measures – general	Thorough and regular cleaning regime Infection Control PPE as appropriate Social distancing is practised Controlled movement between areas Stagger drop-off and collection times
Safety measures – families	Parents/Carers are asked to reinforce the practice of social distancing at home and reinforce this message with their child(ren). Parents/Carers are instructed to monitor their child’s health and should refrain from sending their child to school if they or themselves are displaying Coronavirus symptoms. Parents/Carers are asked to notify the school immediately if anyone in their household displays symptoms of Covid-19 Parents’ drop-off and pick-up protocols will be established to minimise adult contact
Lunches	On arrival you will be asked if your child has a packed lunch or will require a school lunch.
Clothing	Children should not wear school uniform, instead we would encourage clean clothes are worn every day and that they are suitable for the weather forecast.
