This brings our overall total to £1314!

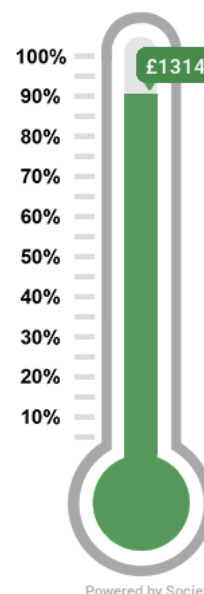
### Calderstones Mansion
